15	shall be owned and operated by the authority or financed under AS 44.88.172, 44.88.650
16	44.88.690, or 44.88.800 - 44.88.840. The principal amount of the bonds provided by the
17	authority for critical mineral and rare earth element projects may not exceed \$300,000,000
18	and may include the costs of issuing bonds considered reasonable and appropriate by the
19	authority. The bonds shall be repaid from revenues of the authority.
20	(b) The Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority may issue the bonds
21	under this section in a single issuance or in several issuances, without limitation as to the
22	number of issuances or timing, and as the authority determines best furthers the purpose of
