Here is the excerpted bullet from our POTUS letter. We also have Kip working follow up on our asks the letter contains.

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- **Clean Water Act 404 veto** – Natural resource development in Alaska is handicapped due to the EPA’s failure to officially announce that a preemptive Clean Water Act 404 veto is not going to be used anywhere in the state. The Pebble Mine Project is the poster child, but every potential investor must evaluate whether that preemptive veto could be used against their project; which results in a serious brake that chill potential resource development opportunities.
