Peak Gold to utilize Fort Knox's mill and infrastructure and leverage the mine's successful 27-year history

- Peak Gold is located approximately 400km southeast of Fort Knox, near Tok, Alaska and within a 675,000-acre (2,732 km²) mineral lease with the Native Village of Tetlin
- Access to Fort Knox from Peak Gold is via the Alaska Highway, which is maintained by the state
 - No special permit is required for trucking ore
- Kinross has been operating the Fort Knox mine since 1997
 - Strong, working relationship with regional authorities and the community
 - Existing network of local contractors and suppliers
- Mining-friendly jurisdiction; several operating gold mines and projects in the region
