

SENATOR KAWASAKI reviewed the Boards and Commission's filing for Mr. Doyle. He referenced the bachelor's and master's degrees Mr. Doyle holds. He stated that RCA commissioner qualifications require an appointee to be member in good standing with the Alaska Bar Association or have a degree with a major in engineering, finance, economics, accounting, business administration, or public administration. He wondered if either of Mr. Doyle's degrees fit the requirement.

MR. DOYLE replied yes, he achieved a Public School of Administration master's degree from the University of Alaska Anchorage. He added that he worked as a human resource director for the school district and the assistant superintendent of finance.
