


Why did ASD wait until July 25 to inform schools of the guidance?



ASD did not wait until July 25. ASD took over management of Family Partnership in April and learned of use of allotments that do not comply with the Alaska Constitution. [On June 29, ASD issued a memorandum](#) to all of its correspondence schools, including FPCS, with the same guidance that is contained in the [July 25 memorandum](#). ASD directed correspondence principals to provide the information in the June 29 memo to staff and families. Because FPCS had questions about the June 29 memo, ASD issued the July 25 revised memo, but the revised memo added just a few words and did not change any of the guidance.
