

College Board provides a fee reduction of \$36 per AP Exam, including AP Seminar and AP Research Exams, for qualifying low-income students in Florida. Schools are also expected to forgo their \$9 rebate for these students. For eligibility criteria, visit [AP Exam Fee Reductions](#).

- Final AP Exam fee to be paid to College Board for fee-reduced students for each AP Exam (except AP Seminar and AP Research Exams): **\$53\***
- Final AP Exam fee to be paid to College Board for fee-reduced students for each AP Seminar Exam and each AP Research Exam: **\$101\***

\*The State of Florida provides state funds to school districts to cover the cost of all public school students' AP Exam fees through the Florida Education Finance Program (Section 1011.62(1), paragraphs (a) and (n), Florida Statutes). Public school AP students are exempt from the payment of any fees for the administration of AP Exams (Section 1007.27(6), Florida Statutes). Each public school pays College Board for AP Exam fees using these funds.
