

Yesterday, the court system released the final decision from the Superior Court and granted a stay until June 30. As a result of the Superior Court's final decision, my administration will ask the Alaska Supreme Court to extend the stay and issue a decision on an expedited timeframe.

At the same time, the House Education Committee is hearing a bill that could be a vehicle to ensure Alaska's public homeschooling through the correspondence program remains intact and functions in a manner conducive to the educational needs of its more than 22,000 students, thousands of parents and thousands of vendors that assist with the correspondence process. #akleg
