



## **Legislative Action Alert!**

At 10 a.m. this morning, the Legislature will meet to consider a proposal to distribute a **\$525 PFD** to Alaskans - the lowest amount in our state's history. Despite bipartisan support for a \$2,350 PFD and permanent constitutional protections, a small group of powerful legislators has once again pulled a number for the PFD out of thin air. Worse, they've tied funding for critical infrastructure projects, school funding, and the Troopers to their PFD scheme in an attempt to coerce their colleagues.
